## How to hard reset ipod nano

How do I reboot or restart a "frozen" or "hung" iPod? First, check to make sure that the iPod isn't paused or that the "hold switch" is in the "locked position" as indicated by a small "padlock" icon on the screen (if applicable) and color visible on the right side of the "hold switch" (on the top of the iPod). If the iPod isn't paused or locked, you will need to reset your iPod. The steps to reboot or restart your iPod are different depending on the model. For the original iPod, iPod (2nd Gen), and iPod (3rd Gen) plug the iPod into the power adapter and plug the power adapter into an electrical outlet (or plug the iPod into a computer), and reset it by depressing the "menu" and "play/pause" simultaneously and continue to hold both buttons until the Apple logo appears. For all models with a "clickwheel" – starting with the iPod (4th Gen) and provided by all subsequent models with the exception of the iPod shuffle and iPod touch lines and the iPod nano (6th Gen) – plug the iPod to the power adapter and plug the power adapter into an electrical outlet (or plug the iPod into a computer), and reset it by depressing the "menu" and "select" (the center button) until the Apple logo appears. For additional details on resetting the iPod, please refer to "Resetting iPod" from the Apple Support Site. For the iPod shuffle models, move the switch to the "off" position, wait for five seconds, and switch it back on. For details, please refer to "Resetting iPod shuffle" from the Apple Support Site. For the iPod touch models, "press and hold the sleep/wake button and the home button at the same time for at least ten seconds until the Apple logo appears". For more information, please refer to "Turning on/off and resetting iPod touch and iPhone" from the Apple Support Site. For the iPod nano (6th Gen), "press the Sleep/Wake button and the Volume Down button for 6 seconds, until the Apple logo appears." Reset your iPod. 2. Retry your iPod with a different USB or FireWire port on your computer (please note that the latest iPods can only be synced through USB). Reinstall your iPod and iTunes software. You can download the latest versions of iPod Updater and iTunes from our website. 5. Restore your iPod using the latest iPod Updater. Please note that restoring an iPod will erase all songs and files on your iPod and restore it back to its original settings. After restoring, you can transfer your music and files from your computer back to your iPod again. Each iPod has its own method of resetting the device without having to connect it to iTunes. Once you have reset the iPod, you can access the device again. However, after a reset, most of your content remains but your settings get restored to the iPod's default configuration. Knowing how to reset your iPod comes in handy if it has frozen before or during your company's presentation and you need it to access audio. The Nano is really easy to reset if you forgot iPod password without iTunes being available. Connect your iPod Nano to a power source if you have one available. You can also run off the battery if needed. Just make sure it has a good charge. Press the Sleep/Wake button and the Volume Down buttons together. Continue the simultaneous hold for a good eight seconds. This will send the iPod Nano into a reset. If it does not work, you may not have held the buttons down at the exact same time. Repeat the same process one more time to reset and unlock the iPod. The Shuffle model has a process that differs from the Nano. Go ahead and slide the switch to the Off position, and wait for a full five seconds. Return the switch to the On position and hold until the green stripe appears. Your iPod Shuffle will reset to normal after running this basic power cycle. You are not required to sign in to iTunes or take any special steps. You can only add and subtract music through iTunes but the reset allows the iPod to function normally otherwise. Like most iPod models, the Touch is also really easy to use. The primary difference is the touch screen, which essentially created an iPod with a more robust set of menu options and controls. The previous models were limited to a few basic buttons and did not have a touch screen. The lack of additional buttons helped to keep the devices compact. Hold the Sleep/Wake button until the Slide to Power Off slider shows up. Swipe from left to right to turn the iPod off. If your iPod doesn't respond, continue to the next step. The touch screen can become problematic if your iPod touch has been exposed to water or any abuse. Press the Sleep/Wake and Home buttons for 10 seconds. Continue holding until you see the Apple logo. This will reset your iPod Touch. Both methods of running the power cycle are equally effective, and they take a matter of seconds to execute. On older iPods that have a scroll wheel, touch wheel or dock connector, slide the Hold switch on and off. Hold the Play/Pause and Menu buttons together for about eight seconds. Repeat this process until the iPod resets. When your iPod is disabled for some reason, this reset will usually restore performance to normal. If the reset does not work, you may require additional troubleshooting through iTunes to restore functionality. You may need to perform a password reset to access your iTunes account for this process. In most cases however, a simple reset is sufficient. WARNING !Hard Reset will erase all of your data. All described operations you are doing at your own risk. Help! This doesn't work. 7th generation iPod nano: Simultaneously press and hold the Hold and Home buttons. When the screen goes dark, release both buttons.6th generation: Press and hold the Sleep/Wake and Volume Down buttons for at least 8 seconds. Release when you see the Apple logo.Older: Slide the Hold switch to On, then move it back to Off. Press and hold the Menu button and the Center button at the same time. This article explains how to reset your iPod nano if it isn't responding to clicks and won't play music. Resetting your iPod nano is simple and takes only a few seconds. (While Apple discontinued the iPod nano on July 27, 2017, the devices are still in use.) The 7th generation iPod nano looks like a shrunken iPod touch and is the only nano that offers features like a multitouch screen, Bluetooth support, and a Home button. The way you reset it is also unique (though resetting the 7th generation nano will be familiar if you've used an iPhone or iPod touch). Press and hold the Hold button (located in the upper-right corner) and the Home button (located on the bottom front) at the same time. When the screen goes dark, release both buttons. In a few seconds, the Apple logo appears, which means the nano is restarting. In a few seconds, you'll be back at the main screen, ready to go. If you need to restart your 6th generation nano, follow these steps: Press and hold the Sleep/Wake button (located on the top right) and the Volume Down button (located on the far left) for at least 8 seconds. The screen will go dark as the nano restarts. When you see the Apple logo, release the buttons. The nano starts up again. If this doesn't work, repeat from the beginning. A few tries should do the trick. Resetting the early iPod nano models is similar to the technique used for the 6th generation model, though the buttons are slightly different. Before doing anything else, make sure that the Hold button isn't on. This is the switch at the top of the iPod nano that locks the iPod buttons. When you lock the nano, it won't respond to clicks, which makes it appear to be frozen. You'll know that the Hold button is on if you see an orange area near the switch and a lock icon on the screen. If you see either of these indicators, move the switch back and see if this fixes the problem. If the nano isn't locked: Slide the Hold switch to the On position (so that the orange appears), then move it back to Off. Press and hold the Menu button on the click wheel and the Center button at the same time. Hold for 6 to 10 seconds. This process should reset the iPod nano. You'll know it's restarting when the screen darkens and the Apple logo appears. If this doesn't work the first time, repeat the steps. The steps to restart a nano are simple, but what if they didn't work? There are two things you should try at that point: Plug the iPod nano into a power source (such as a computer or a wall outlet) and let it charge for an hour or more. It could be that the battery is run down and needs to recharge. If you charged the nano and tried the reset steps, and your nano still doesn't work, you may have a problem that you can't solve on your own. Contact Apple to get more help.
